# **Privacy Policy**

Last updated on September 27, 2021.

It describes the policies and procedures for collecting, using, and disclosing your information when you use the service. It also discusses your privacy rights and legal protections.

The policy states that your personal data is used to provide and improve the service, and by using the service, you agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

### 1. Interpretation and definitions

### Interpretation

Words beginning with a capital letter are defined in the following sections. The following definitions have the same meaning whether used in the singular or plural.

### Definitions

For the purposes of this Privacy Policy:

• Account refers to a unique account created for you to access the service or its parts.

• We/Us/Our refers to the website.

• **Cookies** are small files placed on your computer, mobile device, or any other device by the website, containing details of your browsing history on the website.

• **Device** means any device that can access the service, such as a computer, mobile phone, or digital tablet.

- Personal Data is any information relating to an identified or identifiable individual.
- Service refers to the website.

• **Service Provider** means any natural or legal person who processes the data on behalf of the website. This includes third-party companies or individuals employed by the website to facilitate the service, provide the service on behalf of the website, perform services related to the service, or assist in analyzing how the service is used.

• Third-Party Social Network and Messenger Service: Refers to any website or social network/messenger service through which a user can log in or create an account to use the service.

• **Usage Data**: Data collected automatically or generated when using the service or from the service infrastructure, like the duration of a page visit.

• Website: Specifies the website accessible at https://push.express/.

• You: Indicates the individual accessing or using the service, or a company or other legal entity on behalf of which such an individual accesses or uses the service, depending on the context.

# 2. Collection and use of your personal data

### 2.1. Types of data collected

### Personal data

When using our Service, we may ask you to provide us with certain

personal information that can be used to contact or identify you.

Personally identifiable information may include, but is not limited to:

- Email address
- Telegram account name
- Phone number
- Usage data

### Usage data

Usage Data is collected automatically when you use the service.

Usage Data may include information such as your device's Internet Protocol address (such as IP address), browser type, browser version, the pages of our service that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages, unique device identifiers and other diagnostic data.

When you access the service with or through a mobile device, we may collect certain information automatically, including, but not limited to, the type of mobile device you are using, your mobile device's unique identifier, your mobile device's IP address, your mobile phone number, operating system, the type of mobile Internet browser you use, unique device identifiers and other diagnostic data.

We may also collect information that your browser sends whenever you visit our service or when you access the service using or through a mobile device.

Information from third-party social networks and instant messengers

We may provide the ability to create an account and log in to use the service through the following third party social networking and messenger services:

- Telegram
- •Google
- Facebook
- Twitter

If you choose to register through or otherwise provide us access to a third party social networking and messenger service, we may collect personal data that is already associated with your third party social networking and messenger service account, such as your name, your email address, phone number, your actions or your list contacts associated with this account.

You may also have the opportunity to share additional information with us through your third party social media and messenger service account. If you choose to provide such information and personal data during registration or otherwise, you grant us permission to use, transfer and store it in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

### Tracking technologies and cookies

We use cookies and similar tracking technologies to track activities on our service and store certain information. The tracking technologies used are beacons, tags, and scripts to collect and track information as well as to improve and analyze our service. The technologies we use may include:

• Browser Cookies or Cookies. A cookie is a small file placed on your device. You can instruct your browser to refuse all cookies or to indicate when a cookie is being sent. However, if you do not accept cookies, you may not be able to use some parts of our service. If you have not adjusted your browser setting so that it refuses cookies, our service may use cookies.

• Flash Cookies. Some features of our service may use local stored objects (or flash cookies) to collect and store information about your preferences or your activity on our service. Flash cookies are not managed by the same browser settings as browser cookies. • Web Beacons. Some sections of our service and our emails may contain small electronic files known as web beacons (also referred to as clear gifs, pixel tags, and single-pixel gifs) that allow us, for example, to count users who have visited these pages or opened an email and other related website statistics (for example, recording the popularity of a certain section and verifying system and server integrity).

Cookies can be 'persistent' or 'session' cookies. Persistent cookies remain on your personal computer or mobile device when you go offline, while session cookies are deleted as soon as you close your web browser.

We use both session and persistent cookies for the purposes outlined below:

Necessary/Important Cookies

Type: Session Cookies

Purpose: These cookies are essential to provide you with services available through the website and to use some of its features. They help authenticate users and prevent fraudulent use of user accounts. Without these cookies, the services cannot be provided, and we use these cookies only to provide you with those services.

Cookie Policy / Notice Acceptance Cookies

Type: Persistent Cookies

Purpose: These cookies identify whether users have consented to the use of cookies on the website.

• Functional Cookies

Type: Persistent Cookies

Purpose: These cookies allow us to remember choices you make when using the Website, such as remembering your login details or language preferences. The purpose of these cookies is to provide you with a more personal experience and to avoid having to re-enter your preferences every time you use the website.

### 2.2. Use of your Personal Data

We may use Personal Data for the following purposes:

• To provide and maintain our service, including to monitor the usage of our service.

• **To manage your account:** to manage your registration as a user of the service. The Personal Data you provide can give you access to different functionalities of the service that are available to you as a registered user.

• For the performance of a contract: the development, compliance, and undertaking of the purchase contract for the products, services, or any other contract with us through the service.

• **To contact you**: to communicate with you by email, telephone calls, SMS, or other equivalent forms of electronic communication, such as the mobile application's push notifications regarding updates or informative communications related to the functionalities, products, or contracted services, including the security updates, when necessary or reasonable for their implementation.

• **To provide you** with news, special offers, and general information about other goods, services, and events which we offer that are similar to those that you have already purchased or enquired about unless you have opted not to receive such information.

• To manage your requests: to attend and manage your requests to us.

• For business transfers: we may use your information to evaluate or conduct a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of our assets, whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation, or similar proceeding, in which Personal Data about our service users stored by us is among the assets transferred.

• For other purposes: we may use your information for other purposes, such as data analysis, identifying usage trends, determining the effectiveness of our promotional campaigns, and to evaluate and improve our service, products, services, marketing, and your experience.

We may share your personal information in the following situations:

• With service providers: we may share your personal information with service providers to monitor and analyze the use of our service, and to contact you.

• For business transfers: we may share or transfer your personal information in connection with, or during negotiations of, any merger, sale of company assets, financing, or acquisition of all or a portion of our business.

• With affiliates: we may share your information with Our affiliates, in which case we will require those affiliates to comply with this Privacy Policy. Affiliates include our joint venture partners or other companies that we control or that are under common control with Us.

• With business partners: we may share your information with our business partners to offer you certain products, services, or promotions.

• With other users: when you share personal information or otherwise interact in public areas with other users, such information may be viewed by all users and may be publicly distributed outside. If you interact with other users or register through a third-party social network or messaging service, your contacts on the third-party service can see your name, profile, pictures, and description of your activity. Similarly, other users will be able to view descriptions of your activity, communicate with you, and view your profile.

• With your consent: We may disclose your personal information for any other purpose with your consent.

### 2.3. Storage of your Personal Data

We will store your personal data only for as long as is necessary for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy. We will retain and use your personal data to the extent necessary to comply with our legal obligations (for example, if we are required to retain your data to comply with applicable laws), resolve disputes, and enforce our legal agreements and policies.

We will also retain usage data for internal analysis purposes. Usage data is generally stored for a shorter period of time, except when this data is used to strengthen security or to improve the functionality of our service, or we are legally obligated to retain this data for longer time periods.

### 2.4. Transfer of your Personal Data

Your information, including Personal Data, is processed at our operating offices and in any other places where the parties involved in the processing are located. This means that this information may be transferred to — and maintained on — computers located

outside of your state, province, country, or other governmental jurisdiction where the data protection laws may differ from those of your jurisdiction.

Your consent to this Privacy Policy followed by your submission of such information represents your agreement to that transfer.

We will take all reasonably necessary steps to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy Policy and no transfer of your personal data will take place to an organization or a country unless there are adequate controls in place including the security of your data and other personal information.

# 2.5. Disclosure of your Personal Data

### **Business transactions**

If we are involved in a merger, acquisition, or asset sale, your personal data may be transferred. We will notify you before your personal data is transferred and becomes subject to a different Privacy Policy.

#### **Governmental Authorities**

Under certain circumstances, we may be required to disclose your Personal Data if required to do so by law or in response to valid requests by public authorities (e.g., a court or a government agency).

### Other legal requirements

We may disclose your Personal Data if we believe in good faith that such action is necessary to:

- Comply with a legal obligation
- Protect and defend our rights or property
- Prevent and/or investigate possible wrongdoing in connection with the service
- Protect the personal safety of users of the service or the public
- Protect against legal liability

# 2.6. Security of your Personal Data

The security of your personal data is important to us, but remember that no method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage, is 100% secure. Although we use commercially acceptable means to protect your personal information, we cannot ensure its absolute security.

# 3. Children's Privacy

Our service is not intended for individuals under the age of 13. We do not knowingly collect personal information from individuals under 13. If you are a parent or guardian and you are aware that your child has provided us with personal information, please contact us. If We become aware that we have collected personal information from anyone under the age of 13 without verification of parental consent, We will take steps to delete that information from our servers.

If we need to rely on consent as the legal basis for processing your information, and your country requires parental consent, we may require the consent of one of your parents before we collect and use that information.

### 4. Links to other sites

Our service may contain links to other websites that we do not operate. If you click on a third-party link, you will be directed to that third party's site. We strongly advise you to review the Privacy Policy of every site you visit.

We have no control over and assume no responsibility for the content, privacy policies, or practices of any third-party sites or services.
